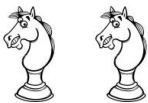

JOHN'S CONCISE & PRECISE NUGGETS

On the King's Gambit. This is probably the most aggressive attacking opening for White there is- or it definitely ranks up there for sure. So what is it? The King's Gambit is an opening pattern that starts e4 e5 f4!? White immediately breaks the rule 'you shouldn't really move your F pawn out too early- (as it opens lines to your King). White is hoping to open early and difficult lines to Black's King however instead! That is, via a Knight f3, Bishop c4, castling and taking pawns to try and get to Black's most vulnerable point f7 first! A 19th century mainstay, that's rare + useful today! The King's Gambit is an all-out kitchen sink attack!

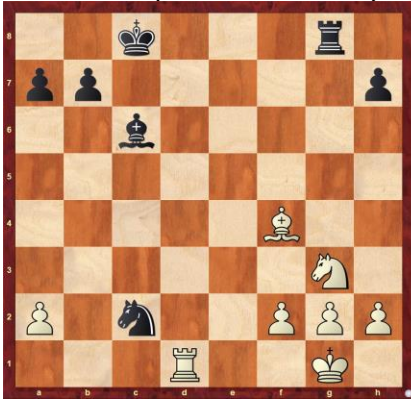

Here you play Black. How can Black defend their position without losing? *Hint: Try to create a double threat :)*
